



# Prohibited Item List

*In order to maintain a safe, enjoyable experience for everyone, and to remain in compliance with EAA, Scouting America, and AEB policy, please review the list of prohibited items when packing to attend the Aviation Exploration Base. Additionally, take note of the items we recommend against bringing (but which are not prohibited).*

## **Prohibited Items:**

- Beer, wine, liquor, and all other alcoholic beverages
- Recreational marijuana (THC/cannabis)
- Firearms, fireworks, explosives
- Laser pointers
- Cigarettes, E-cigarettes, cigars, pipes, or other items that produce smoke or simulated smoke for inhalation
  - Note: Adults who wish to smoke may do so off AEB grounds, subject to the policies of the EAA
- Large table umbrellas, sport-brellas, or shade tents
- Pop-up canopies (Tent rows are reserved for tents only)
- Pets and emotional support animals (note that service animals are not considered pets)
- Knives with blades longer than 4 inches
- Bicycles, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, “Razor”-style scooters, hoverboards, and other personal mobility devices except for ADA accessibility
- Oversized backpacks (outside of AEB grounds)
- Anything that can be used as, or considered to be, a weapon
- Anything that can be considered, by statute, as illegal or contraband
- Inappropriate, revealing, or offensive clothing

**Recommended not to bring:**

- Fidget spinners and other focus-distracting items (prohibited while on duty)
- Electronic devices, especially expensive items like laptop computers
- Extra large tents with flat walls (dome tents handle storms better)
- Expensive jewelry
- Drones or RC Planes (flying these in Oshkosh airspace prohibited)
- More than you can comfortably carry for 300 feet
