A few weeks ago it was New York, but as of the publication date of this newsletter, Wisconsin is rated as having the worst air quality in the country.

Nearly 500 Canadian wildfires are still burning and more than 250 of them are rated as being out of control. With Canada having the worst wildfire season in the past
