



Simple Packing List

Weather: Expect temperatures ranging from 50-60 in the mornings and evenings to 75-90 during the day. Every year there is at least one major storm during the week.

Space and Weight: Be mindful of how much space you have, especially if traveling a long distance. Work with your post to share items where possible, such as stake hammers or air pumps.

Clothing:

- Pajamas
- Socks
- Sturdy shoes (hiking boots
tennis shoes)
- Extra shoes (shoes may get
wet)
- Underwear
- Shirts
- Long Pants & Shorts
- Hat/Visor
- Sweatshirt/Jacket
- Rain gear / Poncho
- Sunglasses

Toiletries:

- Towel/Washcloth
- Soap / Body Wipes
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Comb/Brush
- Personal Medication (if
needed)
- Shower Shoes

Bedding:

- Sleeping Bag / Bedding
- Pillow
- Air Mattress / Cot
- Tent (plan to share with a
buddy as space is limited)

Miscellaneous:

- Flashlight
- A good book to read
- Camp chair
- Bug spray
- Garbage bags, Ziplocks, or a
tub to keep clothes dry
- Sunscreen SPF 30+
- Pack for cool and hot weather

What NOT to Bring:

- Expensive items and jewelry
- Fireworks and sparklers
- Bikes, scooters, skateboards,
roller shoes, laser pointers
- More than you can
comfortably carry 100 yards
