This matrix is to be used as a reference for the Aviation Exploration Base (AEB) as we navigate COVID-19 cases and potential cases. Please refer to the definition and appendix below when using the matrix. For all cases, confirm with Katie Clark at kclark@aviationexplorationbase.org.

We encourage all campers attending the Aviation Exploration Base to take a COVID-19 test the morning before leaving for Oshkosh.

Exposure:

Close contact includes:

- Being within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or more cumulatively over a 24-hour period

Tested Positive	<p>...and you have not yet arrived to camp, contact Katie Clark for next steps.</p> <p>...and you are already at the Aviation Exploration Base, isolate immediately. You will need to make arrangements to go home.</p>	N/A	If you isolated at home and 5 or more days have passed, you have been fever-free for 24 hours, all other symptoms have resolved, and after gaining clearance from Katie Clark.	<p>If returned to camp on Day 6 or later, wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days in indoor spaces (including the kitchen and office).</p> <p>Individuals must bring their own tent.</p>
Been Exposed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Symptoms • Regardless of Vaccine Status 	No quarantine needed.	<p>If you develop symptoms, see “Developed Symptoms” procedure.</p> <p>If you do not develop symptoms, CDC recommends to get tested at least 5 days after you last had close contact with someone with COVID-19.</p>	Same day.	<p>If you have not had COVID-19 within 90 days, wear a well-fitting mask around others in indoor spaces for 5 days. If you test negative on day 5 or later, you do not need to continue mask-wearing.</p> <p>If you do not test, wear a mask for the duration of camp.</p>
Developed Symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regardless of All Variables (including those who have had COVID-19 within 90 days). 	<p>Varies based on test results and symptom duration.</p> <p>The day symptoms begin is Day 0.</p>	<p>If you do not feel well, inform your advisor.</p> <p>If you develop symptoms, the CDC recommends testing immediately and again if symptoms persist.</p>	<p>Symptoms will be handled on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>All campers who leave the Aviation Exploration Base due to illness or testing positive will not be able to return later in the week.</p>	Maintain at least 6 ft. and wear a well-fitting mask in indoor spaces and when around others while symptoms persist.
